No Fiscal Impact

Section 1 of the amendment tasks the Departments of Public Health (DPH) and Revenue Services (DRS) with studying the sustainability of funding for DPH's community gun violence intervention and prevention program, which does not result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities. DPH and DRS have the necessary expertise to complete the required study.

Section 2 of the amendment requires specified annual reporting by DPH, which is like is, likewise, not anticipated to have a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
