No Fiscal Impact

The amendment replaces Section 1 of the underlying bill, along with its associated fiscal impact, and replaces it with language tasking the Department of Public Health (DPH) and Office of Policy and Management (OPM) with studying the sustainability of funding for DPH's community gun violence intervention and prevention program, which does not result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities. DPH and OPM have the necessary expertise to complete the required study.
