OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the state or municipalities. The amendment requires that under the Department of Housing's (DOH's) Rental Assistance Program, if the fair market rent established by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is higher than DOH's applicable maximum allowable rent, the HUD fair market rent will apply as the rent maximum for that unit. This provision is not anticipated to result in additional costs because DOH's maximum allowable rents are generally higher than HUD's fair market rents and the Rental Assistance Program operates within available appropriations.
