No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and results in the fiscal impact below.

The amendment makes a variety of campaign finance reforms concerning attribution requirements, transfers between campaign committees and creates a CPI adjustment for aggregate contributions, individual contributions, grants, and organizational contributions. The amendment also shifts the beginning date keeping current practice in place for the November 2024 elections.
