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## ***OFA Fiscal Note***

### ***Explanation***

Section 6 of the bill allows any federally recognized tribe in the state to opt into the Family and Medical Leave Insurance Program after executing a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Governor. The amendment clarifies that such MOU must be under the same terms and conditions currently in place for participants of the program. This does not result in a fiscal impact on the Family Medical Leave Insurance Trust Fund to the extent that this potential expansion would mirror the expenditure and revenue trends of the existing program.
