Cost

The amendment results in a cost to the state to appropriate funding to private nonprofit provider organizations contracted to provide direct health and human services for clients of the Departments of Aging and Disability Services, Children and Families, Correction, Developmental Services, Housing, Mental Health and Addiction Services, Public Health and Social Services, the Office of Early Childhood, and the Judicial Department. The extent of the cost will depend on how much money is appropriated.
