Potential Savings

The amendment requires the state's area agencies on aging (AAAs) to submit continuity of effort plans to the Commissioner of Aging and Disability Services by January 1, 2025. The AAAs are also required to notify the municipal, state, and federal officials that operate within their areas of service when they are experiencing high levels of demand. These requirements do not result in a fiscal impact for the state or municipalities.

The amendment also gives the Commissioner the ability to withhold funding to an AAA should they not comply with either of these provisions. This results in potential savings to the state to the extent that AAAs do not comply and have their funding withheld.
