**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONSIDERATION OF FAMILIAL  
RELATIONSHIP DURING THE ADMISSIONS PROCESS BY AN  
INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2024*) The Office of Higher Education shall  
4 study the (1) overhead costs, including, but not limited to, fixed costs  
5 and ongoing expenses, of the Board of Regents for Higher Education  
6 and the Board of Trustees of The University of Connecticut for operating  
7 the public institutions of higher education under each board's  
8 governance compared to such overhead costs at similar public  
9 institutions of higher education in other states or independent  
10 institutions of higher education, and (2) work load of faculty employed  
11 at a public institution of higher education in the state compared to the

12 work load of faculty at similar public institutions of higher education in  
13 other states or independent institutions of higher education. Not later  
14 than January 1, 2025, the office shall submit, in accordance with the  
15 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing  
16 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters  
17 relating to higher education and employment advancement a report on  
18 its findings from such study."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
