**"AN ACT CONCERNING CONSUMER PROTECTION FOR CUSTOMERS OF SOLAR POWER COMPANIES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2024*) Any municipality that has  
4 at least three existing solar farms within the boundaries of such  
5 municipality may establish a moratorium on the construction or  
6 installation of any new solar farm in such municipality. If any such  
7 municipality establishes such a moratorium, the Connecticut Siting  
8 Council, or any zoning commission in such municipality,  
9 notwithstanding any provision of title 8 of the general statutes or  
10 chapter 277a of the general statutes, shall not approve any new solar  
11 farm in such municipality. As used in this section, "solar farm" means a  
12 solar array that is installed on the ground and consists of multiple solar  
13 photovoltaic panels."
