Senate Bill No. 1152

*Senate, March 6, 2025*

The Committee on Veterans' and Military Affairs reported through SEN. HONIG of the 8th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE MILITARY DEPARTMENT FOR THE JOINT ENLISTMENT ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2025*) The sum of one hundred sixty-nine
- 2 thousand dollars is appropriated to the Military Department from the
- 3 General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, for the purpose
- 4 of supporting the department's joint enlistment enhancement program.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>July 1, 2025</i>	New section
