**AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES' RECOMMENDATIONS FOR REVISIONS TO PROVISIONS CONCERNING CONTRACTING, REAL ESTATE, STATE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES AND PROBATE COURT NOTIFICATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 4b-56 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1,*  
3 *2025*):

4 (a) There shall be established within the Department of  
5 Administrative Services state construction services selection panels  
6 which (1) for projects valued at [~~five~~] seven million five hundred  
7 thousand dollars or more, [~~shall~~] consist of five members, four of whom  
8 [~~shall be~~] are current or retired employees of the Department of  
9 Administrative Services appointed by the commissioner and one of  
10 whom [~~shall be~~] is appointed by the head or acting head of the user  
11 agency, and (2) for projects valued at less than [~~five~~] seven million five  
12 hundred thousand dollars, [~~shall~~] consist of three members, two of  
13 whom [~~shall be~~] are current or retired employees of the Department of  
14 Administrative Services appointed by the commissioner and one of  
15 whom [~~shall be~~] is appointed by the head or acting head of the user  
16 agency. Each member of a section panel, regardless of the appointing  
17 authority, shall serve only for deliberations involving the project for  
18 which such member is appointed.

19 Sec. 2. Section 112 of public act 23-205 is repealed. (*Effective from*

20 *passage)*

21     Sec. 3. Section 4a-57e of the general statutes is repealed. (*Effective from*

22 *passage)*
