## **REASONS FOR BILL:**

The bill seeks to require that the fee charged by an adjuster is based on how much the insurer pays to the insured in the event of a loss, and that this fee is only collected by the adjuster after the insurer has paid this money to the insured.

The prior statute had a similar effect, but this bill would clarify the language of the statute to ensure that it is in line with the way the statute has been interpreted.
