AN ACT CONCERNING TRACKING OF ABSENTEE BALLOTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 145 of the general statutes be amended to establish an
- 2 online and mobile-accessible system to allow each elector who has
- 3 returned an absentee ballot via mail or secure drop box to be able to
- 4 monitor such elector's ballot progress toward being counted on the day
- 5 of a primary or election, through the use of unique, trackable and
- 6 scannable barcodes at various checkpoints in the process, and which
- 7 system shall securely maintain personal data associated with
- 8 monitoring such ballot only for election-related purposes.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a secure, online and mobile-accessible system to allow electors who have returned absentee ballots to monitor such ballots progress toward being counted on the day of a primary or election.
