AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUSPENSION OF MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS' LICENSES FOR FAILURE TO PAY FINES OR FEES OR FAILURE TO APPEAR FOR A SCHEDULED COURT APPEARANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 246 of the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit
- 2 the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles from suspending a license solely
- 3 for failing to pay fines, fees or other charges resulting from a motor
- 4 vehicle infraction or violation or for failure to appear for any scheduled
- 5 court appearance with regard to any such infraction or violation, and (2)
- 6 restore the operator's license of any person whose license was
- 7 suspended for such failure.

Statement of Purpose:

To end the suspension of motor vehicle operators' licenses solely for failure to pay fines or fees or failure to appear for a scheduled court appearance in order to help low-income persons who need transportation for their livelihood.
