AN ACT CONCERNING THE BREEDING OF ANIMALS IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the breeding of
- 2 animals, including birds and reptiles, unless such person or company is
- 3 registered with the Department of Agriculture. Additionally, to require
- 4 the Department of Agriculture to create guidelines for the breeding of
- 5 animals, develop a breeder registry, collect registration fees and
- 6 perform annual inspections of such breeders.

Statement of Purpose:

To regulate animal breeding in the state through the Department of Agriculture.
