AN ACT REQUIRING A REPORT CONCERNING HEALTH CARE PLANS, RETIREMENT PLANS AND OTHER BENEFITS PROVIDED BY NONSTATE PUBLIC EMPLOYERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 3-123xxx of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

3 (a) Not later than October 1, 2019, and annually thereafter, each
4 nonstate public employer shall submit a report to the Comptroller,
5 Office of Policy and Management and Office of Fiscal Analysis, in a form
6 and manner prescribed by the Comptroller. Such report shall contain (1)
7 the total number of employees covered under a health care plan
8 sponsored by such employer, (2) the coverage type selected by each
9 covered employee, (3) the total premium for each coverage type,
10 inclusive of employee and employer shares and medical and pharmacy
11 coverage, (4) the amount of any contributions by such employer to
12 health savings or health reimbursement accounts, (5) the number of
13 participants in such health care plans, including employee dependents,
14 (6) a summary of benefits and coverage for each health care plan offered

15 by such employer and the number of employees enrolled in each such
16 plan, and (7) information concerning retirement plans and benefits
17 offered or provided by such employer and the total costs to such
18 employer associated with the provision of such plans and benefits in the
19 preceding year.

20 (b) Not later than January 1, 2026, and annually thereafter, the
21 Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall submit a report,
22 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a, to the joint standing
23 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
24 relating to planning and development. Such report shall contain a
25 summary and analysis of the information contained in the reports
26 submitted by nonstate public employers pursuant to subsection (a) of
27 this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management to submit a report summarizing and analyzing reports received from nonstate public employers concerning health care plans, retirement plans and other benefits.
