**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A WORKING GROUP TO EXAMINE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A UNIFORM ENERGY STORAGE CAPACITY TAX.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a working  
2 group to examine the implementation of a uniform energy storage  
3 capacity tax in the state, including, but not limited to, the methodology  
4 for calculating such a tax and a recommended rate for such tax. The  
5 working group shall consist of (1) the chairpersons and ranking  
6 members of the joint standing committees of the General Assembly  
7 having cognizance of matters relating to finance, revenue and bonding  
8 and energy and technology, (2) the Commissioners of Energy and  
9 Environmental Protection and Revenue Services, or their designees, (3)  
10 a representative of the Connecticut Green Bank, and (4) any individuals  
11 or businesses said chairpersons and ranking members deem relevant or  
12 necessary to carry out such examination. The chairpersons of the joint  
13 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of  
14 matters relating to finance, revenue and bonding shall serve as

15 cochairpersons of the working group.

16 (b) The cochairpersons of the working group shall jointly schedule  
17 the first meeting of the working group, which shall be held not later than  
18 sixty days after the effective date of this section.

19 (c) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the  
20 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to finance,  
21 revenue and bonding shall serve as administrative staff of the working  
22 group.

23 (d) Not later than January 1, 2026, the working group shall submit a  
24 report on its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly,  
25 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.  
26 The working group shall terminate on the date that it submits such  
27 report or January 1, 2026, whichever is later.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
