**AN ACT PROHIBITING CERTAIN CONDUCT CONCERNING DRUGS  
AND MEDICAL DEVICES USED TO EXECUTE THE DEATH PENALTY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that certain persons
- 2 who are licensed, registered or doing business in this state shall not
- 3 manufacture, compound, sell, test, distribute, dispense or supply any
- 4 drug or medical device for the purpose of executing the death penalty.
