AN ACT PROHIBITING ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION COMPANIES FROM COLLECTING FEES OTHER THAN FEES FOR THE PURCHASE OR DELIVERY OF ELECTRICITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 16 of the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit any
- 2 electric distribution company from charging any end use customer of
- 3 such company any fee other than a fee for the purchase or delivery of
- 4 electricity provided to such customer, and (2) establish a private cause
- 5 of action under chapter 735a of the general statutes for any end use
- 6 customer charged a fee by any electric distribution company other than
- 7 a fee for the purchase or delivery of electricity provided to such
- 8 customer.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit electric distribution companies from collecting fees other than fees for the purchase or delivery of electricity and to establish a private cause of action under the Connecticut Unfair Trade Practices Act against electric distribution companies that charge unlawful fees.
