AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN SURGICAL PROCEDURES PERFORMED TO TREAT SEVERE OBESITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 700c of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 individual and group health insurance policies provide coverage for
- 3 certain surgical procedures performed to treat severe obesity, including,
- 4 but not limited to, gastric bypass surgery, sleeve gastrectomy and
- 5 duodenal switch surgery.
