**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE STATE FROM MANDATING
EXPERIMENTAL OR EMERGENCY VACCINATIONS, DISCLOSURE
OF VACCINATION STATUS OR TESTING FOR ILLNESS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the state, or any
- 2 state employee, from mandating that an employee of the state, a
- 3 nonprofit organization or another entity that receives funding from the
- 4 state, (1) receive an experimental vaccine, a vaccine approved only for
- 5 emergency use or that has not received full approval from the United
- 6 States Food and Drug Administration, (2) disclose such employee's
- 7 vaccination status, or (3) participate in mandatory testing for an illness.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the state from mandating experimental or emergency vaccinations, disclosure of vaccination status or testing for an illness.
