**AN ACT PROHIBITING REQUIRING THE PAYMENT OR PROCESSING
OF STATE LICENSE FEES THROUGH A THIRD-PARTY ENTITY THAT
CHARGES LICENSEES ADDITIONAL FEES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 1-1j of the general statutes be amended to prohibit any
- 2 state agency from requiring the payment or processing of any license fee
- 3 through a third-party entity that requires a processing fee or transaction
- 4 fee to be paid by the licensee in addition to the total cost of the license.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit state agencies from requiring the payment or processing of
any license fee through a third-party entity that requires a processing
fee or transaction fee that would result in additional fees to be paid by
the licensee.
