**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE WORKING GROUP TO STUDY NONALCOHOLIC FATTY LIVER DISEASE.

**Statement of Purpose:** To (1) designate April nineteenth of each year as Connecticut Liver Health Day, and (2) require the Commissioner of Public Health to (A) establish and administer a program to promote liver health in the state and increase public awareness of and education regarding certain liver diseases, (B) develop a plan to provide mobile transient elastography for liver fibrosis in high-risk communities in the state, and (C) develop and implement a 5-2-1-0 Let's Go! campaign.
