The amendment strikes the language of the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact.

Section 1 shifts the effective date from May 1, 2026 to January 1, 2028 associated with sections 5, 6, and 7 of SB 6 as amended by Senate Amendment Schedules "A" and "C". This results in a shift in costs to municipalities and the Office of Early Childhood related to licensing municipal youth camps as well as a shift in potential savings to municipalities related to the employment of physicians or advanced practice registered nurses.
