[S.B. No. 62](#) (COMM) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF A NEW PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A DOCK WHEN THE FORMER PERMIT HAS EXPIRED', to expedite the issuance of a new permit to build a dock when the former permit has expired but there are no changes to the application for such permit.

[S.B. No. 64](#) (COMM) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING REPORTING OF BIOMASS FERTILIZERS DISTRIBUTED TO FARMERS IN EASTERN CONNECTICUT', to require the publication of records concerning the distribution of biomass fertilizer to farmers in Eastern Connecticut.

[S.B. No. 72](#) (COMM) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT REQUIRING LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION'S EVICTION OF FARMERS CONDUCTING FARMING ON STATE-OWNED PROPERTY', to protect farmers who permissibly farm on state-owned land.

[S.B. No. 78](#) (COMM) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT PROVIDING FOR LOCAL REPRESENTATION ON THE CONNECTICUT SITING COUNCIL', to provide local representation on the Connecticut Siting Council.

[S.B. No. 884](#) (COMM) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE CONCENTRATION FOR 1,4-DIOXANE IN HOUSEHOLD CLEANING AND PERSONAL CARE PRODUCTS AND COSMETICS', to protect the public health and the environment by reducing exposure to harmful contaminants in household cleaning, personal care and cosmetic products and encourage safer manufacturing practices.

[S.B. No. 887](#) (COMM) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN COOKWARE FROM PFAS REQUIREMENTS', to exempt certain cookware from the statutory PFAS requirements applicable to consumer goods.

REF. ENVIRONMENT

S.B. No. 1278 (RAISED) AGING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE PREMIUM RATES', to (1) allow an income tax deduction for long-term care insurance premiums, (2) require the Insurance Department to hold a public hearing for long-term care premium rate increase requests that exceed ten per cent, and (3) require that policyholders are provided advance notice of such hearing.

S.B. No. 1279 (RAISED) AGING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING NURSING HOME STAFFING RATIOS', to (1) establish minimum nursing home staffing levels, and (2) impose stricter penalties for violations.

S.B. No. 1280 (RAISED) AGING. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMMUNITY OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM', to allow the Community Ombudsman program to oversee home and community-based long-term services and supports.

REF. AGING

S.B. No. 1281 (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY ON THE NEED FOR EXTENDED PRODUCER RESPONSIBILITY FOR SOLAR PANELS AND WIND TURBINE BLADES', to study the need to establish extended producer responsibility programs for solar panels and wind turbine blades.

S.B. No. 1282 (RAISED) ENVIRONMENT. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE MINIMUM QUARANTINE FOR CERTAIN DOGS AND CATS EXPOSED TO RABIES', to reduce the minimum quarantine time from six to four months for dogs, cats and other animals that have been attacked and that may have been exposed to rabies.

S.B. No. 1283 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF THE CONNECTICUT UNIFORM COLLABORATIVE LAW ACT', to adopt the Connecticut Uniform Collaborative Law Act.

S.B. No. 1284 (RAISED) JUDICIARY. 'AN ACT CONCERNING THE ILLEGAL USE OF CERTAIN VEHICLES AND STREET TAKEOVERS', to (1) revise provisions regarding forfeiture of certain illegally used vehicles, (2) authorize municipalities to adopt an ordinance related to street takeovers, and (3) revise the time period for suspension of an operator's license and to allow for revocation of a license due to violations related to a street takeover.
