



Dear Youth Justice Colleagues,

Public Act 16-147 Sec. 2 required Judicial Branch Court Support Services Division(CSSD) to develop and implement a detention risk assessment instrument and adopt a release policies and procedures effective January 1, 2017. An update to the Juvenile Justice Policy and Oversight Committee (JJPOC) by the Incarceration work group was done at the Dec 15th meeting. Per the request of the JJPOC, CSSD has shared their training video that is provided to Juvenile Judges on the new Detention Risk Screening Instrument. The training video details what a risk screening is, how the instrument was developed, understanding of the components/items of the risk screen are, and how the detention risk screening will be utilized during the juvenile court process.
