

I do not think putting armed guards in every school is a reasonable answer to increasing public safety. The more guns we have in a school the greater the risk of injury to students and staff. A crazed gunman will find a way in avoiding the guard, whether armed or not. Reducing the type and number of weapons available, limiting sales of guns, (especially assault weapons) multiple clip ammunition cartridges, tightening background checks so they are always mandatory no matter where guns are sold, and increasing our mental health services and vigilance will be more effective in increasing public safety.
