

1. Perform mental health evaluations at firearm purchaser expense. Psychological written test or evaluation by psychiatrist or psychologist can be prerequisite to all sales. Mental health professionals should be held harmless except in case of gross negligence.
2. Appeals process established. Failure of mental health evaluation and appeal would disqualify firearm purchaser for a period of (x) years.
3. Firearm purchaser disclosure of all people sharing residence. If it is established someone residing with purchaser presents a threat, such purchaser would be required to submit a plan for securing weapons and ammunition inside a safe etc.
4. Ban all semi-automatic assault style rifles.
5. Ban clips of more than 10 rounds.
6. Homeland Security provides school security recommendations.
7. Lobby congress to pass legislation providing school districts with a combination of funding and tax incentives to implement measures.
8. State establish a substantial reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of a person planning to attack a school.
