As many gun owners claim that having "assault style" weapons are just for target shooting, then lets require that all of these weapons be required to be kept at a target range at all times and not at home. As gun owners say they wouldn't use them to defend their property anyway there is no need for them to be kept on their property.

Additionally to this a target range should be required to have tighter security, such as the guns must still have trigger locks that the gun owner would have the key to so if the guns were stolen they couldn't be used. Also the guns would still need to be in a safe, and lastly the gun shop would be required to have a security system that would alert a company like ADT or Sonitrol and have a very restrictive SLA (service level agreement) so the alert would be responded to in a timely fashion and police notified if needed.
