

I am strongly in favor of banning assault type weapons, high capacity magazines, and requiring background checks. But, I also like the idea requiring that gun permits be renewed on an annual basis. This would help track the guns and make sure they are not falling into the wrong hands. It would also bring revenue into the state by attaching a renewal fee.

With respect to annual revenues, I recommend the following:

That a portion of the revenue from the renewals be devoted to gun buy-back programs and that fines be levied against anyone who fails to renew their gun permits.
