

To Connecticut State Legislators

Immediate changes needed now:

1. Military style rapid fire weapons with high capacity magazines pose a significant threat to the public when they are widely available and unregulated.

3. Registration of all gun sales.
4. Annual registration of all guns.

It is time for Connecticut to add to the laws that protect our children, and all of us, from gun violence. I hope that Connecticut will serve as a model for our country.
