I want to see tighter gun safety laws in Connecticut.

In the home, guns should be kept locked, and ammunition locked up separately from guns. Children should not have access to the keys until age 18, not 16 as is currently the law.

The ATF should be allowed to keep computerized record,d not restricted to only paper records.

The ATF should be allowed to make more than one unscheduled visit to gun shops per year.

The tax on guns, gun parts, ammunition, shells and gunpowder must be high enough to cover the cost to society imposed by gun violence; this would include the cost to medical facilities treating victims of gun violence.

Background checks are needed for all who wish to purchase ammunition or ammunition parts.
