Subject: SB 124- AN ACT BANNING LARGE CAPACITY AMMUNITION MAGAZINES.

I do not agree with the entire contents of, or purpose of this bill.

By limiting the number bullets a person can legally have at their disposal in one magazine is very concerning as there have been, and will be instances when a person will need to defend themselves and their families from multiple attackers.

A magazine that is only capable of containing 10 rounds, in most cases, will not be sufficient.

Criminals will still have access to and the high capacity magazines, leaving the law abiding citizen at a disadvantage.

There are many cases documented but in recent days, a Loganville, Ga. Mom, Mrs. Melinda Herman, barely defended herself and her two 9 year old twins against one intruder using 5 rounds. If there were multiple intruders the result could have been similar to the Petit family from Cheshire, CT.
