

As a veteran and lawful owner of firearms in Connecticut I was saddened to see the governor bypass your working group yesterday. I hope that your group can still come to some reasonable approach to any potential new guns laws.

One area that I would respectfully request the working group consider is an exemption to any so-called assault weapons ban for those firearms that qualify under the Federal Curios and Relics Firearms license. From what I can ascertain at this point, the governor's proposals could ban many historical and collectible rifles, particularly from the World War II and Korean War era. I do not think this would be necessary but it certainly could be the unintended consequence of a poorly drafted law.
