

I am strongly opposed to the gun control legislation that has come about due to the tragedy that recently occurred at the Sandy Hook Elementary School . While I grieve for all of us affected, and wish for such an occurrence to never again happen, I also realize that attacking the Constitutional rights of the law abiding is not the proper corrective measure to take.
