

Pursuant to Senate Resolution 200, the Senate Bipartisan Committee of Review is reviewing available information about the events leading up to Senator Louis C. DeLuca's guilty plea on the misdemeanor charge of conspiracy to commit threatening in the second degree.

To assist us in our endeavor, we ask that you provide the investigation file of your office and other related information on Senator DeLuca, including information documenting or indicating the nature and existence of any on-going relationship between Senator DeLuca and James Galante. Additionally, we would like information in your offices' files on Richard Caccavale that relate to the DeLuca investigation, including information that documents a relationship between Senator DeLuca and James Galante.

The committee's next meeting is Thursday, September 6, 2007. Accordingly, please provide the information by September 5, 2007. If you cannot meet this deadline, please indicate the date by which we can expect to get the information. If there are any documents in your possession that would fall within the scope of this request, but that you are withholding, please indicate the nature of each such document and the legal or statutory basis for so withholding.


