

Dear Attorney Raabe:

The Bipartisan Committee of Review is in receipt of your Freedom of Information request, dated October 31, 2007, for all (1) information that the committee has obtained but not posted on its website and (2) records of communications between the committee, its members, staff, or counsel with any third party. The committee is in the process of complying with the request. Certain of the requested communications may (1) fall within exemptions to disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act, including, but not limited to, the preliminary drafts or notes exemption (CGS § 1-210 (b) (1)) or (2) be prohibited from disclosure under the exception for communications between government attorneys and public officials (CGS § 52-146r).

As you know, the committee determined early on to make all public documents in its possession available to the public. Consequently, the committee has not waited for members of the public to make Freedom of Information requests before disclosing these documents. Instead, realizing the public's interest in the committee and its assignment, we have made public access easier by placing the documents in a central location on the Connecticut General Assembly's website.
