SPRAGUE--Mansfield D., 95. Of Ojai, CA, March 25, 2006. Born December 1, 1910, graduate of Dartmouth College and Yale Law School. Practiced law and was a Lieutenant in US Navy 1943-1945. Served 3 terms in the Connecticut House and was Speaker in 1954. Appointed General Counsel of the Dept. of Defense in 1955 by President Eisenhower and later as Asst. Secretary of International Security Affairs. In 1959, became VP and director of AMF, Inc. Served as Counselor to Secretary Elliot Richardson at the Dept. of Commerce in 1976. Survived by wife, Chilant, daughter, Susan, son, Daniel, 3 grandsons and 6 great-grandchildren.
