

## 1/8/21 PTATF Public Awareness Youth Work Group Summary

The meeting was convened at 1:34 pm.

Andrew Clark began the meeting checking in with each of the co-sponsoring groups holding the Youth Listening Sessions, UCONN was not present at the meeting. The CTJJA responded that February 16<sup>th</sup> would work better for their group over the originally stated January 26<sup>th</sup> date. CTJJA locked in February 16<sup>th</sup> for their listening session. The NAACP locked in February 2<sup>nd</sup> for their listening session. The NAACP also provided information on a public training they are holding on January 26<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm. The next steps for the UCONN co-sponsoring group is to reach out to Deputy Maggie Silver with the possibility for February 9<sup>th</sup> date to be locked in for the listening session.
