

MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, October 26, 2010

4:00 PM

Room 1B of the Legislative Office Building

I. The meeting was called to order at 4:10 p.m. by Chairman, Rep. O'Neill, A., 69th District. Members present were: Rep. Arthur J. O'Neill, Judge Julia L. Aurigemma, Attorney William R. Breetz, Attorney Jon P. Fitzgerald, Attorney Joel I. Rudikoff, Professor Colin C. Tait, Attorney Thomas Welsh

II. Commission members were introduced and LCO attorneys were introduced to the commission.

III. Chairman Arthur J. O'Neill summarized the recent activity of the Law Revision Commission which culminated in the enactment in 2009 of "AN ACT CONCERNING AMENDMENTS TO THE UNIFORM COMMON INTEREST OWNERSHIP ACT" (P.A. 09-225).

IV. Motion was made by Attorney Thomas Welsh to convene a study committee to evaluate proposed amendments to Article 9 of the Uniform Commercial Code and recommend to the commission such statutory changes as the study committee deems appropriate. Motion was duly seconded by Attorney Jon Fitzgerald. The motion was discussed by Attorney Welsh. The motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

Further discussion occurred regarding the membership and chairpersons of the study committee. Attorney William Breetz indicated that Attorney Thomas Welsh and Attorney Neal Ossen had each indicated a willingness to serve as cochairpersons of the study committee and they were accepted as cochairpersons without objection. Additionally, a list of proposed members of the study committee was discussed. Motion that the proposed list of study committee members be adopted as the membership of the study committee passed unanimously on a voice vote.

Attorney Welsh indicated that the first meeting of the study committee would be Thursday, November 4, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. and that notice would be sent to members of the study committee.

V. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:19 p.m.
