MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, February 22, 2012
1:00 PM

I. The meeting was called to order at 1:35 p.m. by Attorney Thomas J. Welsh. Members present were: Chairman, Rep. Arthur J. O'Neill, 69th District., Attorney Eleanor Michael, Attorney Neal Ossen and Attorney Thomas J. Welsh.

Attorney Welsh reported that the Advisory Committee on the Uniform Certificate of Title for Vessels Act had completed its work at its last meeting on February 21, 2012, and submitted a report to the Law Revision Commission, which included its findings, a proposed draft and an optional amendment relating to a "hull damaged" title brand requirement. Attorney Welsh made a motion for the Law Revision Commission to adopt and approve the Advisory Committee's report and associated bill text. Attorney Michael seconded the motion. The motion passed on a voice vote. Chairman O'Neill stated that the Advisory Committee report and draft would be forwarded to the Judiciary Committee of the General Assembly and possibly the Transportation Committee. He then thanked the members of the Advisory Committee for their work.
