

CT DSS PCMH+ PROGRAM WAVE 1 COMPLIANCE REVIEW FINDINGS WEBINAR

The Person-Centered Medical Home Plus (PCMH+) program is part of the Connecticut Department of Social Services' (DSS') investment in value-based purchasing and care coordination to reduce Medicaid expenditures while improving service quality and member health outcomes. PCMH+ builds on the existing PCMH program initiated by DSS on January 1, 2012, that has successfully supported the practice transformation of 112 practices (as of September 2017) to achieve PCMH recognition and which currently serves 61% of HUSKY Medicaid members.

PCMH+ builds upon the success of the DSS PCMH program by incorporating additional requirements for care coordination, focused upon integration of behavioral and physical health care, children with special health care needs, health equity, and competency in care for individuals with disabilities. It also represents the Department's first use of an upside-only "shared savings" approach under which participating providers that meet specified quality standards and generate savings for Medicaid will receive a portion of the savings that are achieved.

As shared with MAPOC in June 2017, one aspect of the PCMH+ Wave 1 evaluation included conducting Compliance Reviews for each of the nine Participating Entities. PCMH+ Compliance Reviews were conducted by Mercer in August of 2017. DSS and Mercer will be presenting results of those Compliance Reviews via Webinar and welcome your attendance.
