
Glide Path Documentation Status




**PCMH Recruitment Status**

### **Questions and Discussion**

- Rep. Cook thanked DSS and CHNCT for the presentation
- There was discussion about follow-up questions and rescinded application.
- Recruitment staff responded that there has been issues with start-up funds and isn't ready to proceed. The other one submitted it too soon because they were not prepared.
- There were questions about the levels of glidepath. 92 Practices in Open Status.
- There was discussion about practice variations and practice readiness. The staff is learning more about the nature of the practice. Smaller practices it is more difficult for an EHR.
- There was discussion about EHR about getting it right and having meaningful use. A comment about CT is different than other states.
- The enhancement and the readiness evaluation based upon practices and what they need. The Evaluation is going to be on the Husky Health Website.
- Jesse White Fresse inquired about any of the SBHC( School Based Health Centers). They will include the information in the next presentation.
- The Tool kit for NCQA is evidence based material to fulfill the requirements to Glidepath. They are helping them work through the work plans.
- There were questions about how any of this will be affected by political situation nationally.
- They haven't received any notification that was impacting their applications.
- Lisa inquired if the toolkit is in the electronic templates.

### **Disclosure Information and Opt-out Form**

The drafts were sent out in June. The discussion outline their approach. The Provider portal will be up in a couple. There was discussion on the final draft. They haven't received comments from legal services.

The meeting in September will discuss the comments.

Dr. Geerstma commented about incorporating quality improvement research in the portal via. SharePoint. Dr. Geerstma discussed readiness reporting. There was discussion about areas of importance. There should be a List of requirements and reporting features of EHR. List from Vendor needs to be required. There was discussion about quality measures.

When providers have an EHR it is hard to change what they have locked into.

Lisa Honigfeld discussed what practices are doing for care coordination.

Zavoski discussed how they are supporting and helping practices achieve these goals.
