


# Medicare Medicaid Eligibles (MMEs) Integration Initiatives - DRAFT

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**ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1) All individuals in this schematic are Medicare and Medicaid Eligible
- 2) CPCI and PACE are options for MMEs that may emerge in the next 6-24 months
- 3) Based on stakeholder input, it appears that three or more ACOs may emerge in Connecticut; however, no ACOs exist as of January 2012
- 4) Health Neighborhoods (under the ASO option) may employ the Health Home financing vehicle over time
- 5) All models represented could enroll community-based NHC individuals, Institutionally-based NHC individuals, community-well (non-NHC) and may also serve individuals with developmental disabilities, SPMI and physical disabilities
- 6) Enrollment/participation are estimates for discussion purposes only
- 8) The state currently contracts with ASOs that are already managing services for the full population of MMEs (e.g., home health services); however, they not integrating Medicare/Medicaid data or providing ICM services.
