## FY 20 Agency Overtime Report

CGS Sec. 2-53n requires the Office of Fiscal Analysis to quarterly report on the overtime granted by each state agency to its employees. Such report is required to include an analysis of: (1) how much overtime is granted by each state agency, and (2) how many employees received overtime pay.

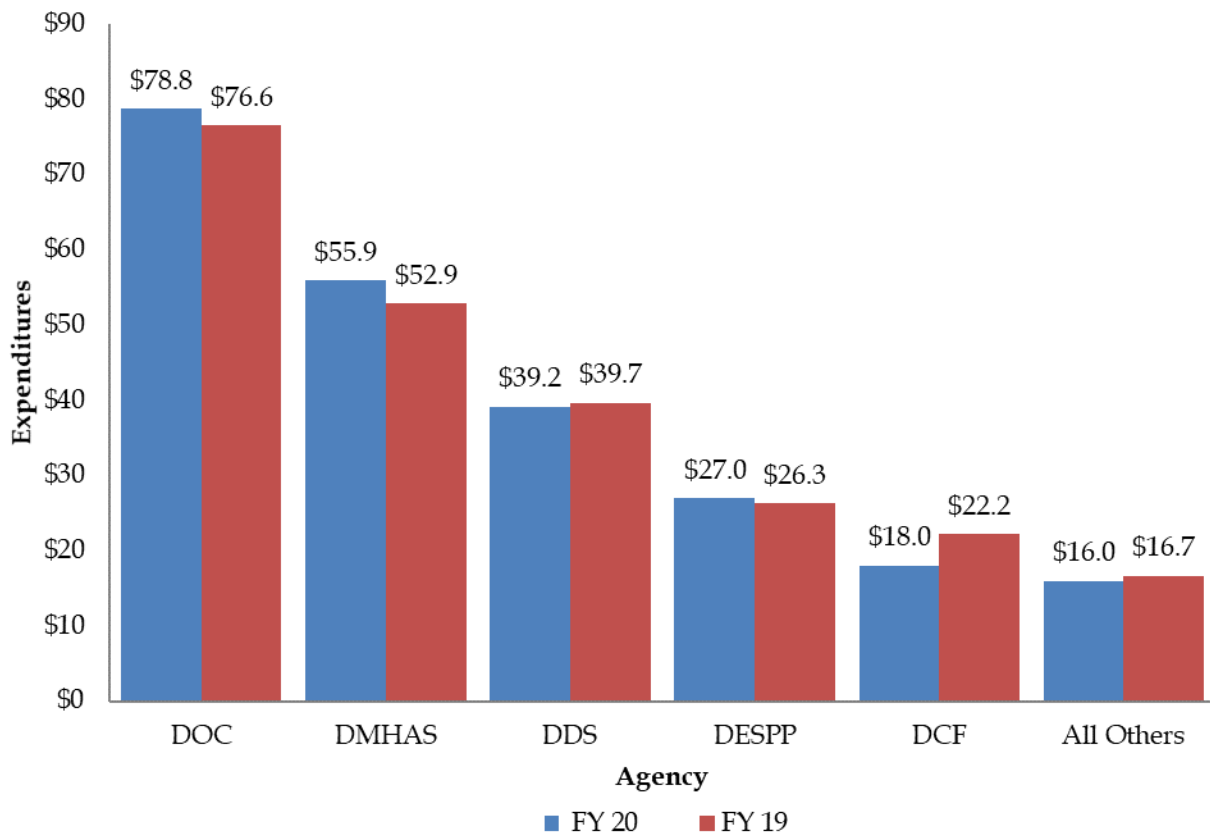
This analysis is restricted to General Fund expenditures only due to availability and reliability issues associated with other funds' expenditure data in Core-CT.

## Summary

In FY 20, the state expended \$234.9 million in General Fund overtime payments, \$.6 million (.2%) more than the overtime expenditures of \$234.3 million in FY 19.

Five agencies account for over 93% of General Fund overtime expenditures in both fiscal years: the departments of: Correction (DOC), Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS), Developmental Services (DDS), Emergency Services and Public Protection (DESPP), and Children and Families (DCF).
