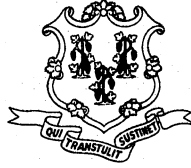

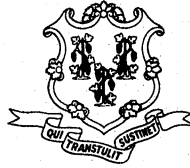

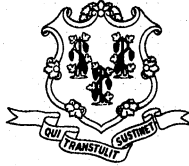
This regulation adds two new fire sprinkler licenses and results in an approximate revenue gain to the state of \$450,000 in FY 20 and \$250,000 in FY 21.
