Quick Facts

ECS FORMULA

The formula is being phased in through FY 28.

- The formula was revised, and a phase-in schedule established, as part of the FY 18 and FY 19 Biennial Budget.
- The phase-in began in FY 19. Towns that are under-funded under the formula will receive increases annually, and towns that are over-funded under the formula will receive reductions annually.
- The FY 20 and FY 21 Biennial Budget (PA 19-117) maintains the formula and the phase-in schedule.
