



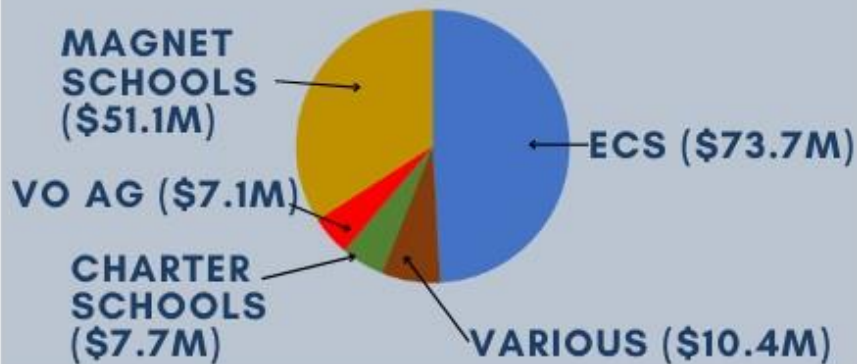
EDUCATION FINANCE REFORM



WHAT IS IT?

A \$150 million FY 25 appropriation established by PA 23-204 to increase funding for ECS and certain choice programs. PA 24-81 adjusted the distribution of the appropriation.

WHAT DOES IT CHANGE?

NOT CHANGING:

- ECS
- CHARTER SCHOOL GRANTS

PA 24-81 MAKES NO CHANGES TO THE UNDERLYING FORMULAS OF THESE GRANTS. IT FUNDS INCREASES REQUIRED BY EXISTING LAW.

CHANGING:

- MAGNET SCHOOL GRANTS
- VOCATIONAL AGRICULTURE GRANTS

PA 24-81 REPLACES THESE GRANTS WITH DIFFERENT FORMULAS FOR FY 25 ONLY.

TUITION AND HOLD HARMLESS

FOR VOCATIONAL AGRICULTURE AND MAGNET SCHOOL OPERATORS

FY 25 TUITION IS CAPPED AT 58% OF FY 24 LEVELS.

THE NEW FORMULAS ENSURE OPERATORS RECEIVE NO LESS IN TOTAL REVENUE PER STUDENT IN FY 25 THAN THEY RECEIVED IN FY 24.

THE FORMULA CHANGES MADE TO VOCATIONAL AGRICULTURE AND MAGNET SCHOOL GRANTS ARE DESCRIBED IN DETAIL IN OTHER DOCUMENTS.

DISTRIBUTION OF VARIOUS INITIATIVES

THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE EDUCATION FINANCE REFORM APPROPRIATION INCLUDES \$10.4 MILLION IN FY 25 FOR A VARIETY OF EDUCATION-RELATED PROGRAMS AND PURPOSES.

DISTRIBUTION OF ADDITIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL SEATS

- 40 SEATS AT BRASS CITY CHARTER SCHOOL
- 36 SEATS AT ODYSSEY COMMUNITY SCHOOL
- 52 SEATS AT INTERDISTRICT SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS AND COMMUNICATION
- 22 SEATS AT INTEGRATED DAY CHARTER SCHOOL

AMOUNT INCLUDES REDUCTION OF 40 SEATS AT BOOKER T. WASHINGTON ACADEMY.
