General Knowledge:

The Office of Information Technology Services at the Connecticut General Assembly is seeking an infrastructure professional with a focus on Storage Area Networks, Storage Arrays (IBM in particular), and connectivity with VMWare systems.

Skills and Experience:

Candidates must possess a broad range of skills and experience with IBM XIV and IBM Flash Storage systems, Brocade / IBM SAN Switches, configuration and management, data migration, and hardware reconfiguration. A fundamental knowledge of project management principles and techniques, and strong documentation and communicative skills are essential. Must be a flexible team player who has the ability to effectively prioritize and juggle multiple concurrent assignments, and exhibits a steady demeanor during stressful and complex situations. Must exhibit a passion for quality and continuous improvement. Must prove 6+ years of relevant work experience.

Responsibilities to include:

Monitoring, management, configuration and continuous improvement of all storage systems. Develops and implements technical specifications, operating standards, and user guides.
