Installation, configuration and support of ESXi hypervisor servers. Knowledge of LAN/WAN networking topology and DHCP/DNS. A fundamental knowledge of project management principles and techniques, and strong documentation and communicative skills are essential. Must be a flexible team player who can effectively prioritize and juggle multiple concurrent assignments. Exhibits a steady demeanor during stressful and complex situations.
